At the beginning in 1980 a group of surgeons from different medical disciplines, and of Public and Private Hospitals, began reuniting with the interest of discussing hand surgery cases and innovations on hand surgery therapy. With time it matured to become a formal Guatemalan Hand Surgery Study Group, it had a monthly meeting and invited all those sectors from the health care services whom were interested on hand surgery topics. This study group became popularly known as the Guatemalan Hand Surgery Association, but it never went through the formalities of becoming a real association, so it was known as one just by name.

The growing interest of prestigious Hand Surgeons, Orthopedic and Trauma surgeons, Plastic surgeons and general surgeons, and all the other interested areas on health care dedicated to the hand, made it possible to give birth to a formal, renewed and reformed Guatemalan Hand Surgery Association, GHSA (Asociación Guatemalteca de Cirugía de la Mano, AGCM) and on the monthly session of the 22 of November of the year 2022 it was legally founded with the guidance of its first formal Chairman Doctor Juan Carlos Gonzalez Morales. This Association went through the formalities of getting registered as a formal nonprofit, educational centered association, dedicated to the sole purpose of enhancing the knowledge and diffusion of hand surgery trough Guatemala. From that year on the association has been conformed by prestigious practitioners with formal training on hand surgery, microsurgery, ortoplastic surgery, braquial plexus and peripheric nerve surgery. All of whom work as an important part of different institutions dedicated to health care on both the public and private sectors. Making it possible to have an organized inter relation with other specialties and sub specialties of health care as Physical medicine and rehabilitation, and therapy and medical education. Making the development of hand surgery and hand therapy the central objective of these inter relations with other specialties, to improve the learning and practice of the art of hand surgery and its global attention for the benefit of the Guatemalan population.

Through its existence the best of interests of the GHSA had been guided to advance in the learning and diffusion of the science and art of hand surgery, microsurgery, plexus and peripheric nerve surgery on Guatemala through its highly qualified specialists. Promoting and stimulating the upgrowing need of knowledge and educational spaces, giving the opportunity to Orthopedic and trauma surgery residents, Orthopedic and trauma surgeons and interested surgeons to quire the needed surgical abilities to facilitate the precise treatment of hand surgery pathologies. Giving the best options of treatments for the patients on Guatemala, and even facilitating information for the patients that helps the understand their pathology and the treatment needed for it on the private



and public health care sectors. The association is working in the production of Guatemalan treatment protocols, based on the economical, physical and existential realities of our country, to

ensure that the hand surgeries are being made with the international quality standards needed to guarantee its results. All this is of a major interest to the GHSA because there are not enough hand surgeons on Guatemala, looking at the fact that Guatemala has only 20 hand surgeons for a upgrowing population of more than 17 million there is not enough surgeons for the hands that need to be treated. So, the responsibility since a long time ago has been taken by other surgeons (Orthopedic and Trauma, Plastic surgery and General surgeons) to help the patients get the needed attention for their hands.

Nowadays the GHSA has eighteen full members and 2 prospect members for the ongoing year, and 4 possible prospect members for the next year. All of its members are listed below:
